





Take 2 wheels to a whole new meaning and experience a taste of the future transport by trying out a Segway with Tackt-isle.

Based in Bembridge and easily reached on bike from Ryde or Sandown you can stop off here for a 30 minute Segway taster sessions. A makeshift course is created and you can practise your skills and race against your family and friends. The Segway is a two-wheeled, self-balancing, battery-powered electric vehicle. Popular in many locations they are a great way to move around and offer a fun activity.

If you are still feeling energetic afterwards you can take the road towards Sandown passing Bembridge Airport and venture up the steep Culver Down. With a varied landscape with wildlife, plants, nesting seabirds and grazing cattle along with spectacular views across the English Channel, Sandown and Bembridge it is the perfect spot to enjoy an afternoon.

For many years the whole site was a military zone and not open to the public. There are several historic military features on the down. The military barracks which once adjoined the monument has been almost completely erased, but there is a substantial fort which was constructed in the 1860s. At the end of the cliff is a coastal and anti-aircraft battery from the Second World War.
