


## **ॐ EASY LOOP WITH SOME ON ROAD SECTIONS**

- START/FINISH: RIVER ROAD CAR PARK, YARMOUTH PO41 ORA
- TIME: 2 HOURS FOR A COUPLE OF LOOPS Bridleways and trail riding, with great views and a good experience of country life on the Island
- DISTANCE: 11km / ELEVATION GAIN: 163m



A START: At the bottom of the car park turn left and follow the Causeway cycle track for 3km towards Freshwater.

**B** Turn left onto the A3055 Afton Road (it's a busy road so take care). The road will take you into Freshwater Bay and onto Gates Road.

Enjoy an ice cream and pop into the Freshwater life boat station. Follow Gates Road and make sure you visit Dimbola Lodge and the

Jimi Hendrix statue. Keep following Gates Road until you meet Bedbury Lane.

**D** Turn right onto Summers Lane and join the bridleway next to Sheepwash Farm. Follow for 300m and join Queens Road. Keep going for 75m until you reach the A3055 School Green Road. Turn left into the school entrance and follow the bridleway next to the school. Keep going for 1km, passing Golden Hill Fort on your right.

E Keep following the path until you pass a building merchants before you join the A3054 Hill Lane. Follow this for 1km. Join Halletts Shute and ride for 2km. Turn right onto A3054 Bridge Road. Cross over the bridge and turn right next to Yarmouth Sailing Club. The path will take you back to River Road car park.

**⊠** FINISH

Where possible, public footpath and bridleway reference numbers have been included in the directions.
