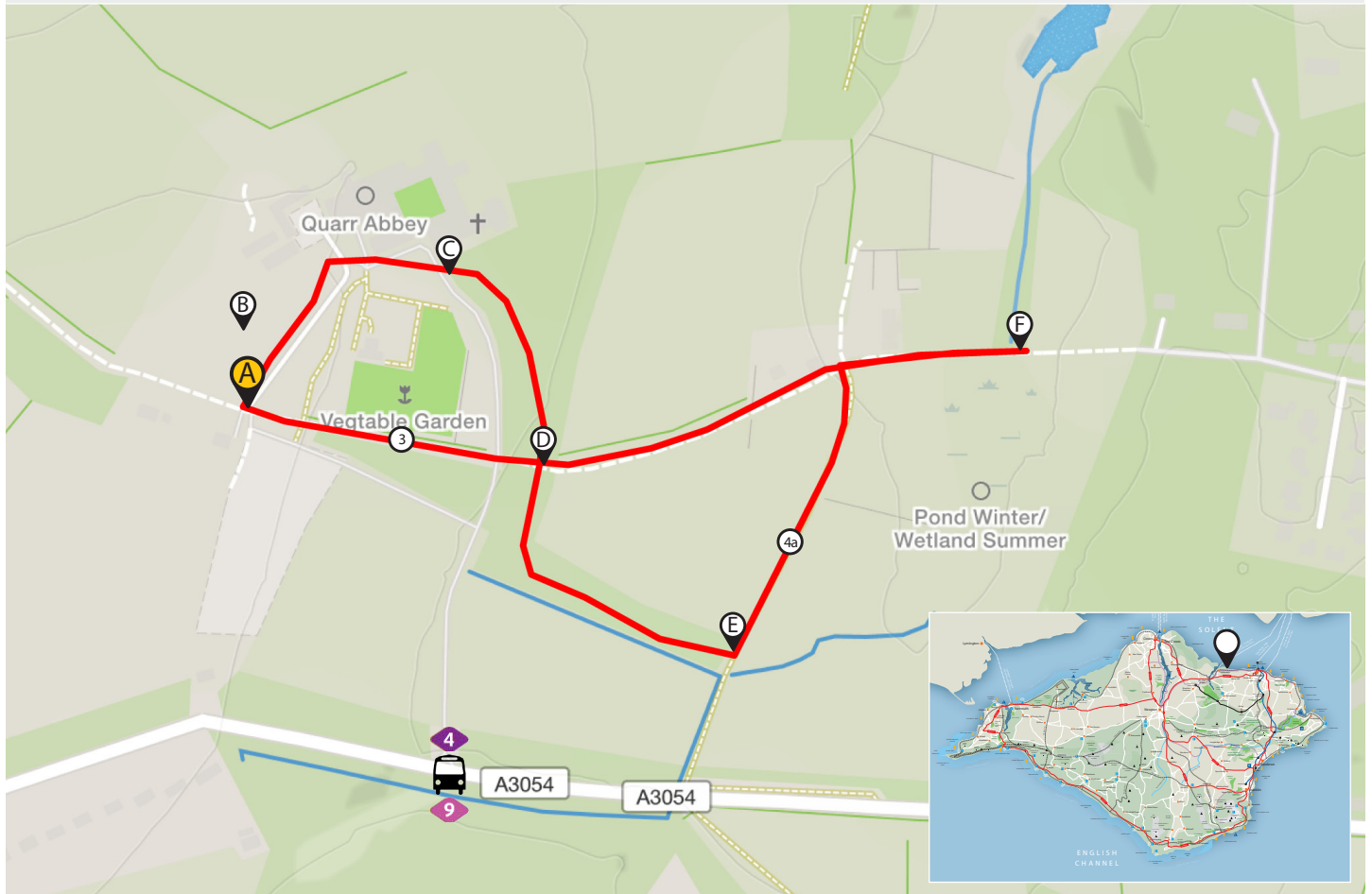


FOR ADVENTUROUS FAMILIES

START/FINISH: Quarr Abbey, Fishbourne, PO33 4ER

TIME: 1 Hour

DISTANCE: 1 mile



DIRECTIONS:

A **START:** The walk starts from the Quarr Abbey Car Park. Cross Bridleway 3 into the Abbey grounds. Make sure you visit the pigs **B** on route.

C Make your way through the Abbey gates and look for the Woodland Walk on your left.

D This is a lovely amble through a small copse and will bring you out on Quarr Road, Bridleway 3. Cross the bridleway and you will enter another small woodland.

E This meandering walk will bring you to Bridleway 4a. Take the bridleway north towards the sea. Look up to see if you can see the mistletoe growing in the trees.

F This Bridleway will bring you out near the Abbey Ruins. The ruins are well worth a look. Try to spot the oak tree that has grown up through the ruined arches. From here it is a short walk back to the start along Quarr Road (Bridleway 3), or possibly (if you are lucky) to the Tea Room. **FINISH**

Where possible, public footpath and bridleway reference numbers have been included in the directions.
