
FOR THE MORE ADVENTUROUS WHO DON'T MIND A BIT OF A CHALLENGE

START/FINISH: Landslip Car Park, Bonchurch

TIME: 2 Hours

DISTANCE: 3 miles



DIRECTIONS:

A START: Starting from Bonchurch Landslip Car Park. Head east on Foot Path 65 and climb down the very steep steps locally known as the Chink. This will bring you on to a narrow foot path, which leads you on many small twists and turns past mini caves. This area is thought to be enchanted, so keep an eye out for fairies and be sure to stop at the Wishing Seat and dream of your heart's desire.

B Foot Path 65 will join the Coastal Path, take a right hand turn and follow the Coastal Path for a ¼ mile.

When you meet a junction take a right turn on to Foot Path 65c and this will take you to the Devil's Chimney. The Devil's Chimney is a yaw between Green Sandstone Blocks and takes you up some very steep and rickety steps to the Smugglers Haven Café.

If you have had enough of your adventure, it is a short walk past the toilet block and the café to the start point Car Park.

• If, however, at this point you have a thirst for more adventure and want to get your heart pumping, continue by crossing the main road and joining Foot Path 109 towards Ventnor.

This path skirts the base of St Boniface Down and will ultimately bring you onto Mitchell Avenue in Ventnor. Walk along Mitchell Avenue in a westerly direction for a few hundred metres until you reach Old Station Road Industrial Estate.

G Walk into Old Station Road and look for an almost secret Foot Path sign (Foot Path 1) which will lead you to the top of St Boniface Down.

Continue up to the top of St Boniface Down, past Ventnor Radar Station (Foot Path 122) and all the way to Nansen Hill Nature Reserve (Foot Path 123).

As you descend from Nansen Hill you will spot the Car Park where you started. A FINISH
